1) POSITION: PONDS AND AQUARIUM ASSISTANT (JOB GRADE WRTI 8 - ONE (1) POSITION – ADVERT REF: NO. WRTI/03/2024)

a) Job Purpose:

Reporting to the Head of Inland Waters and Wetlands Field Centre, the job holder will play a pivotal role in ensuring the smooth operations of both aquaculture facilities and aquarium exhibits. S/he will actively contribute to enhancing both aquaculture and aquarium practices, ensuring compliance with regulations, and promoting educational and engaging displays in the aquarium.
